2024 ELECTION RESULTS

- 85 Emerge Vermont trained women were elected to offices from Selectboard to State House to U.S. Congress.
- 96% of legislative, statewide & federal candidates won their primary races.
- 35 Emerge Vermont trained women were elected to the Vermont Legislature.
